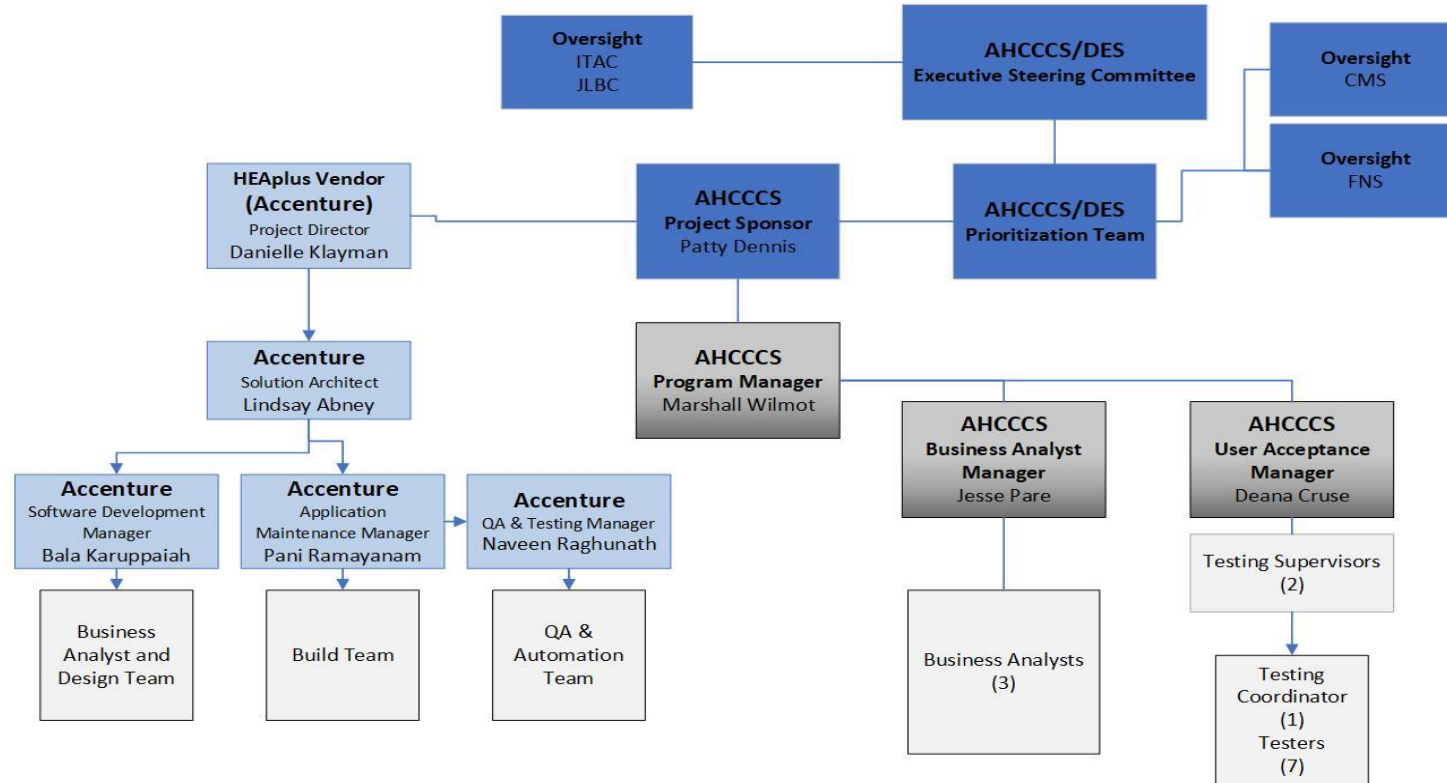

# Project Introduction

## Stated Operational/Business Issue

- Arizona Long Term Care (ALTCs) applications have increased from 2022 to 2023. AHCCCS received 51,734 applications in 2023 which is an increase of over 6,000 more applications annually. This has led to some applications becoming untimely while waiting for a Pre-Admission Screening (PAS) assessment.
- Improving the PAS Assessment process is vital to achieving a better overall experience for AHCCCS staff, and ALTCs customers while improving operational efficiency.

## Benefit to the State Agency and Constituents

- Increased efficiency of PAS casework, and improved quality of PAS assessments.
- Improved PAS assessment process and technologies for PAS assessors, supervisors, and customers.
- Improved organizational culture which helps with recruiting, retention, and operational effectiveness.
- Improvements to overall employee morale.

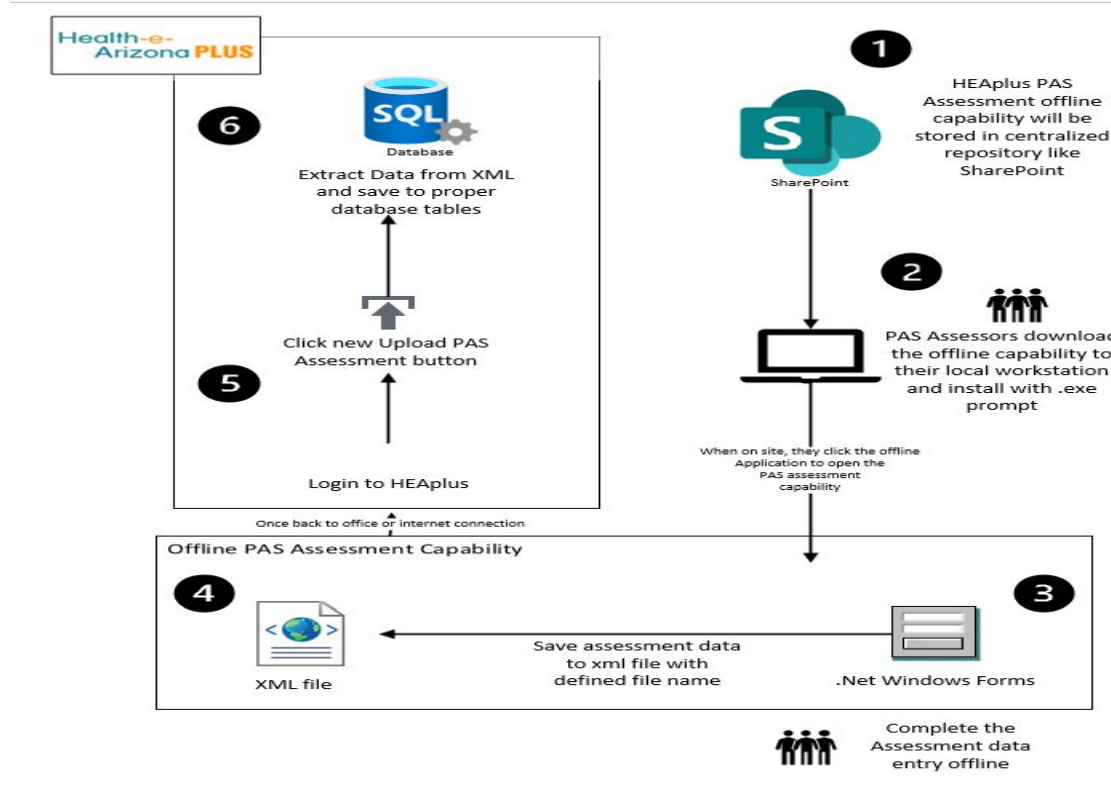
# Proposed Solution— Technology

## Overview of Proposed Solution

AHCCCS has prioritized two enhancements that will provide improvements to the PAS Assessor experience, add efficiencies to the process, and better communicate with customers.

- 1. Develop HEAplus offline capability** to save data and upload once assessor is online, as handwritten or typed answers that are gathered at interviews during a home visit must be manually entered into HEAplus after the fact if the system is unavailable or WiFi is unreliable.
- 2. Configure denial reason functionality** in HEAplus to include “Missing Medical Records” with adequate notification guidance, including sending a PDF of the Authorization for the Disclosure of Protected Health Information (DE202) form. Failure to provide medical records creates an accumulation of open cases, there is currently no denial capability in HEAplus.

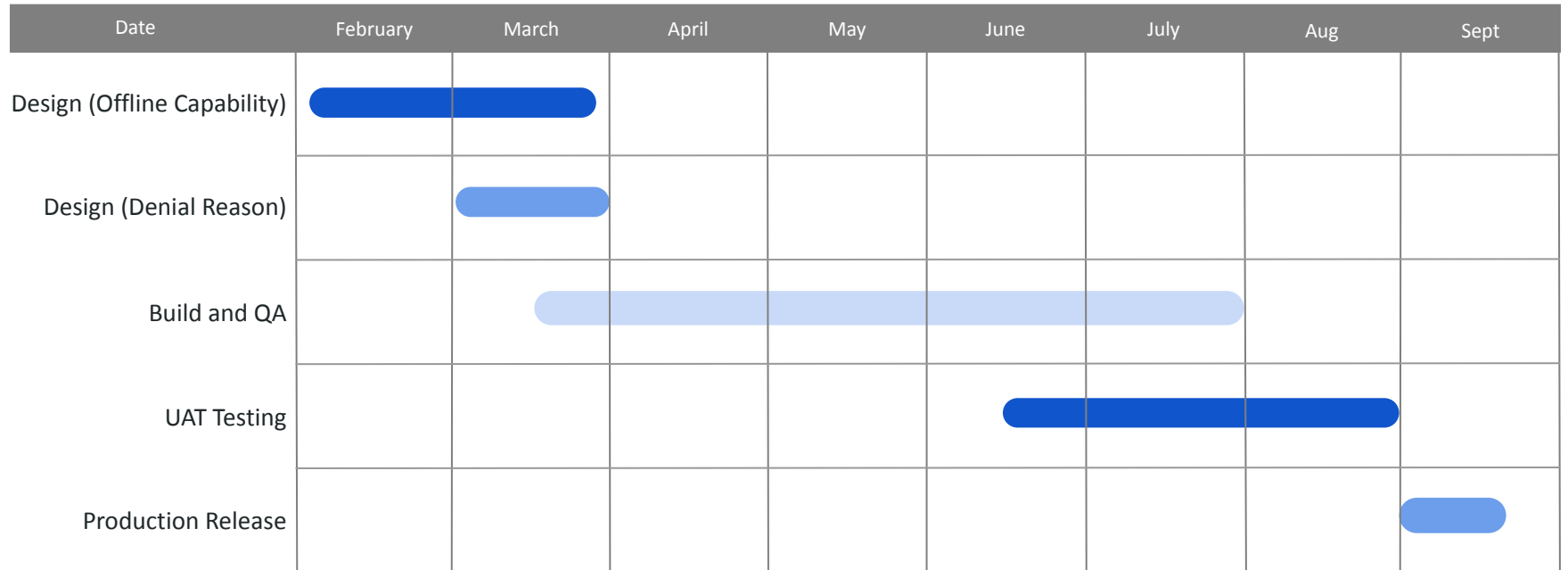

# What Success Looks Like

## Technology and Design Enhancements

- a. HEAplus Offline Capability**
  - a. Eliminate need to have internet at remote or rural locations / home visits.
  - b. Reduce or eliminate impacts to the In-Person / In-Home PAS Assessment when HEAplus is unavailable.
- b. Configure Denial Reason**
  - a. Improved Customer Communication
  - b. Improved timeliness

## Measures of Success

- a. One year after implementation, complete 75% of ALTCS Pre-Admission Screenings within 45 days, compared to 69% in 2023.
- b. One year after implementation, improve external customer overall satisfaction from an average of 55% to 65%. (Ratings are obtained from monthly survey sent by Constant Contact.)

## Recommended Conditions

### ADOA-ASET Conditions

1. Should development costs exceed the approved estimates by 10% or more, or should there be significant changes to the proposed technology scope of work or implementation schedule, the Agency must amend the PIJ to reflect the changes and submit it to ADOA-ASET, and ITAC if required, for review and approval prior to further expenditure of funds.
2. Monthly reporting on the project status is due to ADOA-ASET no later than the 15th of the month following the start of the project. Failure to comply with timely project status reporting will affect the overall project health. The first status report for this project is due on April 15, 2024.

- a. The proposed solution addresses the stated problem or situation;
- b. The budget unit is competent to carry out the project successfully;
