## **STARS Project Overview**

### Description of Project

The State has executed a contract with GCOM Software LLC to provide an enterprise platform for integrated tax administration.

- The RevHub Integrated Tax System (ITS) will contain all tax types and business functions that are administered by the Arizona Department of Revenue (ADOR).
- The RevHub ITS will contain an external facing taxpayer portal that will include all tax types & fees administered by ADOR.
- The RevHub ITS will contain a native income tax policy simulator to be used by ADOR, Office of Strategic Planning and Budget (OSPB) and Joint Legislative Budget Committee (JLBC), meeting the statutory requirement.




