## Overview of Original Project Investment Justification (PIJ):

#### **Background**

AHCCCS is looking to design, develop and implement the Medicaid Enterprise Systems (MES) - Systems Integration Platform. This platform will create a standardized and electronic document and data management solution across enterprise systems, to allow the business to efficiently and effectively make decisions. On **6/21/2023**, ADOA-ASET gave approval to procure the *Systems Integrator* solution.

#### **Benefits of the Systems Integrator Solution:**

- Creates a standardized platform to allow for cost effective integration of current and future systems
- Centralizes the aggregation of the enterprise data and document sets to connect the MES by removing barriers and redundancies through a common systems integration platform
- Standardizes operational reporting, Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) reporting, common data extracts, dashboards, and Transformed Medicaid Statistical Information System (T-MSIS)

The original PIJ spanned 14 months and had total costs of \$34,305,100.

# **Project Status**



## **IV&V** Requirement Update

 CMS no longer requires IV&V for projects and therefore are additional scrutiny in order to secure enhanced funding. AHCCCS budgeted based on enhanced funding, therefore are currently evaluating their options regarding IV&V to meet state requirements and not put funding for project development at risk.

 We are currently working with ADOA-ASET to ensure IV&V requirements are being met, and will keep the committee informed to the process.
