#### Management Summary\*

AZcorrections.gov, the current Arizona Department of Corrections external facing website is a primary source of information about the Department of Corrections for many residents of Arizona. During the last few years there has been a significant growth in the use of mobile devices to view web content. Our current technology does not support many of the new features available with newer web browsers and does not adapt to use on mobile devices. This means that the website is not easy for users to navigate leading to a poor user experience. Due to fact that all changes to the website require the services of a developer to make the changes, it is difficult to ensure that new information is posted in a timely manner and old information that is no longer relevant is removed.

The proposed solution is to use Drupal<sup>™</sup>, a content management solution, as the foundation for the website. This will enable the department to produce an externally facing website whose content can be easily maintained by authorized department staff without the intervention of Information Technology Staff. It has the capability to provide the power and flexibility we require as well as the ability to enforce consistency across all areas of the department to deliver consistent branded web pages. The website will have the ability to determine the type of device that is being used to view the website and adapt accordingly, this means that the website will be viewable on a variety of devices from mobile to desktop. This change will enable the department to more effectively reach out to the residents of Arizona and publish information in a timely manner.

#### III. Business Case

#### A. Business Problem\*

The current Arizona Department of Corrections external facing website is constructed using HTML and .Net technology. This is an old technology that does not support many of the new features available with newer web browsers and is vulnerable to external attacks. During the last few years there has been a

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significant growth in the use of mobile devices to view web content. Our current external website is not capable of detecting the type of device being used to view the department's website and then adapting how the information is displayed to optimize the user's experience. Any change to the content displayed on the external website requires a developer to make the desired changes.

#### B. Proposed Business Solution\*

The proposed solution is to work with Drupal developers to construct a new website using Drupal™, a content management solution. This solution will create an externally facing website that will enable the department to present a modern website whose content can be maintained by authorized department staff with a minimum amount of training. The authorized staff can easily manage the content and diverse functionality at an enterprise scale. It has the capability to provide the power and flexibility we require as well as the ability to enforce consistency across all areas of the department to deliver consistent branded web pages. The websites will be viewable on a variety of devices from mobile devices to desktop clients. A number of custom modules will be developed in Drupal to provide improved functionality.

#### Explain:

The migration of the website to being Drupal based will benefit the Agency and support the States Efficiency Review Initiatives through:

- The service to the department constituents will be enhanced by providing a website that is easy for users to navigate and provides timely information.
  - By providing a website that is more attractive to potential employees with easier navigation to the employment pages the website will be able to support recruiting initiatives more effectively.
  - The ability quickly and easily identifies important information such as visitation status at the prison facilities that will enable the visitors to easily identify when facilities are closed to visitation and avoid unnecessary travel.
- Service to Internal users will be enhanced as power users will have the ability to update content on the website without the services of a developer.
  - This will allow information to be provided in a timely manner.
  - Simplifying the process for displaying high priority notifications in a prominent position. The proposed solution will enable department staff to concentrate on urgent priorities rather than trying to contact a developer to make changes to the website.

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 The department will be able to reduce the risk of data loss through intruders attacking the website. This will be done by updating the applications that gather or provide data to the department, ensure only the data required is gathered, and moving the data to secure locations.

#### IV. Technology Approach

#### A. Proposed Technology Solution\*

ADC will work with Drupal consultants and the Arizona Department of Administration (AZDOA) to create a Drupal Website with responsive themes that will be hosted through AZDOA.

#### B. Technology Environment

The website will be hosted at AZDOA as part of its Drupal environment.

#### C. Selection Process

A statement of work was developed and a request was made to three Drupal consultants as what work they would complete within the proposed budget. Kwall was selected as the preferred vendor based on their experience and proposed solution. As Kwall is not on state contract they will be engaged through Knowledge Services, the State Managed Service Provider.
