Director Davidson,

In response to the amended Project Investment Justification (PIJ) for the “Shared Hosted Data Center” project, the Arizona Department of Administration (ADOA) Strategic Enterprise Technology (ASET) office has reviewed your proposal to establish presence at a hosted data center, which can be leveraged by all agencies as a Shared Hosted Data Center for the State of Arizona, with sufficient capacity and scalability to accommodate all agencies’ needs for on-premise devices that cannot be supported in a Cloud-hosted environment.

The amended PIJ implies funding is available or will be requested from State funds in the amount of \$14,301,729, for a total estimated five-year life cycle cost of the project, which is shown below.

This notification is the Arizona Strategic Enterprise Technology Office’s recommendation to the information Technology Authorization Committee (ITAC) for **Approval with Conditions** of the technology project as follows:

1. Should expenses exceed the estimated costs by 10% or more, or should there be significant changes to the proposed technology, scope of work or implementation schedule, the Agency must amend the PIJ to reflect the changes and submit it to ADOA-ASET for review and approval by ITAC, prior to further expenditure of funds.

The amended PIJ is scheduled to be reviewed by ITAC at the Thursday, July 19th, 2018 meeting. Should the ITAC approve the project, you may then proceed to secure additional approvals as required from the Joint Legislative

Budget Committee, the Office of Strategic Planning and Budgeting, and the State Procurement Office.
