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## **Project Objective**

The Arizona Department of Economic Security (ADES) Division of Technology Services (DTS) needs to migrate the current physical mainframe platform to a shared multi-tenant hosted solution to address the following needs:

- Business
  - At risk of losing Federal Funding due to IRS Audit compliance requirements
  - At risk of losing Department of Labor funding due to inability to conduct required annual disaster recovery validation
  - Loss of mainframe support staffing due to an aging workforce
  - Economic inflexibility
- Technical
  - New business solutions are limited on the mainframe platform

  - IBM z196-503 Hardware
  - 204 MSUs
  - IBM zOS version 2.2
  - 15.9 TB available
  - 134 TB storage
  - 3 LPARs

- 13 Applications
  - Serves approximately 3 million of DES's customers
  - Child Safety
  - Temporary
    Assistance and
    Medical Eligibility
  - Child Support
  - Unemployment benefits




## Approach

- DES requested bids from State Contract vendors
  - Two responses were received and evaluated
    - IBM was the preferred vendor
  - \$6 Million in Development costs
  - Costs are comparable to current system
    - Cost of continuing with current in house solution has estimated 5 year costs of approximately \$50 Million
    - Cost of implementing the IBM hosted solution has estimated 5 year costs of approximately \$40 Million

## Implementation Plan




