ADOA datacenters at Adams and Tucson will be phased out and decommissioned. Specifically the Adams datacenter will be shut down no later than Dec 2019. Sixty percent (60%) of ADOR server hardware is under powered, end of life, or close to being end of life. The increasing strain on the current systems has resulted in backup failures which have led to unrecoverable critical data loss. ADOR is experiencing rapid data growth, expanding virtual server, and application deployments. These dynamics, compounded by demands for faster and easier data recovery, are increasing strain on the current traditional data protection processes that are already broken.
