The Arizona Department of Education presented an update on the Arizona Broadband for Education program. This program's mission is to bring the high-speed Internet (broadband) to areas of the country underserved by existing utilities.

Vast need exists for rural and tribal citizens to have broadband. This presentation of e-rate program was brought to ITAC as information due to the high dollar amount. Corporate fee gathered \$8M, with the fee disappearing in 12 months. This broadband upgrade will benefit all, not just schools.
