**Project Name:** Replacement Analysis for the Arizona Tracking and Locate Automated System (ATLAS)

The Arizona Department of Economic Security (ADES) is proposing to engage a contracting firm to evaluate and assess replacement options for the Arizona Tracking and Locate Automated System (ATLAS). ATLAS is the core system for administering child support cases in Arizona. ATLAS is mainframe-based, is approximately 20 years old and has become deficient in support of business operation in numerous areas. Via the proposed feasibility study assessment, ADES anticipates the ability to recommend a solution and budget for replacement/modernization of ATLAS.

**ITAC Conditional Approval:**

1. The DES may proceed with the discovery phases needed to define requirements, produce a cost benefit study, alternative analysis, and feasibility study. However, DES may not proceed with further development efforts until a full PIJ, reflecting the final costs, scope of work, technology, and implementation schedule for the proposed solution, has been submitted to ADOA-ASET, and the Information Technology Authorization Committee (ITAC) if required, for review and approval.
