#### Program Support Office \$1,500,000 No PIJ required

- Create standards for project design, development and implementation as well as financial oversight for ADE IT's contract laborers
  - Manage risk to ensure projects on time and within budget
  - Increased communication and outreach efforts to build support among users
  - Finance and Procurement for management of opt-in contracts/invoicing and vendor management
- \$175,000 third-party independent assessment
- Staff to manage RFPs, IGAs, ISAs and other contractual obligations
  - Prepare reports and other materials required for AELAS program oversight



#### **Production Services \$2,200,000 No PIJ required for FTE support**

- Sunset legacy services and infrastructure
  - Replace obsolete back up system to ensure agency data security
- Transition application support to full-time employees to ensure that long-term agency vision and strategic direction is maintained
  - Infrastructure and network staffing support
  - ADEConnect
  - AZ Dash
  - Data Governance
  - SIS Opt-In



#### AELAS School Finance \$1,500,000 Amend ED14002 for ITAC review

- Target manual processes for automation to reduce timeconsuming manual effort and analyze core business needs
- Continue automation of manual calculation processes and decoupling of legacy SAIS payment functions from student transactions
  - Automate and decommission 8 manual payment calculation tools.
     Will have completed 29 of 48 by end of FY14
  - Aggregation functions must be decoupled from legacy SAIS and land in the new School Finance payment system
- Complete SAIS School Finance capability replacement is out of scope for FY15, and SAIS sustainability remains a significant risk



#### AELAS Ed-Fi \$2,200,000 Amend ED14004 for ITAC review

- Complete 6 of 10 remaining operational data stores
  - 5 complete and 2 partially complete in FY14
  - 4 remaining data stores complete in FY16
- Populate database environment built in FY14 pilot to comply with Data Governance Commission data collection policy
  - More student transactions will be collected in this format (determined by Phase 1 implementation)



#### AELAS Statewide Longitudinal Data System \$1,500,000 Amend ED14006 for ITAC review

- AZ Dash provides dashboards using the newlyconstructed data stores
- Complete dashboard rollout and training to remaining 400+ LEAs
- Decommission legacy data warehouse



#### AELAS Opt-In SIS \$800,000 AELAS Opt-In Teacher/Learning \$450,000

- Stand up and implement Opt-in SIS to at least 24 LEAs
  - Amend ED14005 to full PIJ for ASET review
- Teacher and Learning tools implementation at least 6 LEAs
  - -Create new PIJ for ASET review
  - -Learning Management System
  - -Teacher Observation
  - -Content Management System



# AELAS Shared Services \$1,000,000 ASET review required


- Organizational Entity Management Phase 2 \$600,000
  - Amend ED14009 for ASET review
  - Complete implementation of role attributes and relationships in CRM
- ADEConnect (Identity Management Solution) \$400,000
  - Create new IMS PIJ for ASET review
  - Rollout to remaining 280 LEAs
  - Create IMS portal for easy customer use
  - Transition to FTE support for sustainability



# AELAS Data Governance \$ 850,000 Pre-PIJ required for ASET review

- Define and build master data dictionary
- Identify reporting requirements (internal, external, state, federal, etc.)
  - Reduce need for external data requests by 80%
  - Consolidate 285 agency data requests to LEAs by at least 50%





### AELAS Current known risks and mitigation

- Size and magnitude of ADE IT project
  - ADE is implementing phase gate and code review processes in each phase of the project to ensure immediate identification of any issues and to audit the progress and deliverables to ensure quality and confirm on-time delivery
  - Team is utilizing industry best practices, as well as highly skilled and senior developers to close the gap in our experience for this type of effort
- Reliance on outside vendors
  - Maintain constant communication through meetings, scope tracking, management and status reports and re-baseline as necessary
- Potentially difficult technical challenges and determination of how to approach challenge
  - ADE has implemented an architectural review team to maintain adherence to overall AELAS architecture and design requirements
